

Christian Union Staff Worker vacancies in the North West

Many thousands of students have come to know and love the Lord Jesus Christ through Christian Unions (CUs). CUs are led by, and made up of students in Higher Education. Christian Union Staff Workers (CUSWs) stand with students in evangelism; train, resource and equip CU leaders; and encourage students to get involved with local churches.

Could you help students unite around the gospel as they seek to bring their friends to Christ? There are 3 posts available in the North West, 1 in each of the following university cities: Lancaster & Cumbria; Lancaster & South Lancashire; Manchester.

As a CUSW you will work directly with students, meeting with CU leaders and working alongside CU members in their outreach to the campus. The strengths each CUSW brings to the role will vary, but at the heart of the work are skills to help students think and live biblically, and the ability to disciple, motivate and influence students to share the gospel.

Furthermore, you will be supported and cared for by your Team Leader, take part in the life of a regional team, partake in UCCF's national Staff Training Programme, and attend conferences and events designed to help you effectively engage with student mission.
